Michael LeBourgeois

Mr. LeBourgeois is Managing Partner at Black Bay Energy, LP (“Black Bay”). Black Bay is a \$224 million private equity fund focused on growth capital investments into companies that provide equipment and technology to the oil & gas industry. Mr. LeBourgeois has over 20 years of investment experience. Prior to forming Black Bay, Mr. LeBourgeois was a Managing Director at NGP Energy Technology Partners (“NGP ETP”), a private equity fund focused on investments into technology and service companies within the energy industry. During his nine-year tenure at NGP ETP, Mr. LeBourgeois was involved with twelve oilfield service investments. Prior to joining NGP ETP in 2007, Mr. LeBourgeois served as the Chief Financial Officer and Vice President of Business Development for Auto-Chlor Services. From 2000 to 2004, Mr. LeBourgeois worked at Bank of America Securities in the Natural Resources Investment Banking Group in New York and Houston, covering energy technology, oilfield services, and refining and marketing companies. From 1998 to 2000, Mr. LeBourgeois worked at Chaffe & Associates, a boutique investment bank, in the M&A group, executing transactions primarily in the energy industry. Mr. LeBourgeois holds an MBA from the A.B. Freeman School of Business at Tulane University and a BA in Economics from Southern Methodist University.
